

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

As our international master's programmes are entirely taught in English, candidates must demonstrate a high level of English proficiency. To be admitted to the English master's programme at **THUAS Pro**, you need a valid language test with a satisfactory score.

Below is a table with the accepted tests and their required scores:

IELTS Academic (No home edition)	Overall score of 6.0 with a minimum of 6.0 in each component.
TOEFL iBT® (<i>not</i> the ITP)	Total score of 80 with a minimum of 20 in each component.
TOEIC 4-skills-tests	Listening + Reading: 670, Speaking + Writing: 290
Cambridge C2 Proficiency	Overall score of 169 (grade A/B/C) with 169 in each component

Exemptions

You may be exempt from providing proof of English proficiency if you were educated in the UK, Ireland, the United States, Canada (excluding Quebec), Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, or Malta, and if your diploma includes English as an exam subject. If your previous education was completed in a country not listed above, or your diploma does not originate from one of those countries, you may still qualify for exemption.

Part-time students currently working in an international (English spoken) environment for at least 2 years, can qualify for a possible exemption on the English level test. This will be assessed during the mandatory intake interview.

Note: If your diploma was issued in one of the exempted countries but your education took place in a non-English-speaking environment, or if we have reason to question your English proficiency, we reserve the right to require you to take a language test.

Dutch language requirements

If you are enrolling in a Dutch-taught programme with a foreign diploma, you will need to demonstrate proficiency in Dutch. This can be achieved by taking the [Dutch as a Second Language, Programme II \(NT2-II\) state exam](#), which includes reading, speaking, writing, and listening components.

THUAS Pro also accepts CNaVT certificates "Educatief Startbekwaam" and "Educatief Professioneel." The CNaVT certificate must be no older than 2 years on 1 September 2024. You can find more information on [the CNaVT website](#).

The submission deadlines for your language test depends on your nationality.

- EU students : 31st July
- Non-EU students : 15th June
