

## Payment options 2024-2025 (NON-EU Master students)

To apply for an entry visa or residence permit for the purpose of studying in the Netherlands, the Immigration and Naturalization Service (IND) requires evidence that you have sufficient financial means to support your living and study expenses during your stay in The Netherlands.

### Applicable costs

The following outlines the financial requirements to study in the Netherlands;

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Please note that The Hague University of Applied Sciences does not have a bank account registered under a name that includes the word "university". We are aware that Stichting translates as foundation in English, however, this is the official name of the organization.

The [appendix](#) to the Dutch Higher Education and Research Act lists all government-funded universities and universities of applied sciences of the Netherlands.

### Please note:

If you choose to pay your tuition fee in installments, the remaining balance will be collected in three separate payments throughout the academic year. You will receive an invoice for each payment, typically in October, February, and April. Additionally, a total administrative fee of €500 will be distributed across these installments.

### Option 1: Package fee

**Transfer the payment of package fee € 37.525,- before the 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2024.**

The package fee is the most common and quickest method, covering all required costs. To proceed, transfer a total of € 37.525,- (thirty-seven thousand five hundred twenty-five euros) to the bank account of **THUAS Pro**.

After deducting applicable costs, you will receive a refund of € 14.618,89 to your Dutch bank account upon your arrival. This refund is intended to cover your living expenses during your stay.

### Option 2: Amount in your own account

**Transfer € 22.906,11 before the 15<sup>th</sup> of June and show proof of € 14.615,52 after payment.**

To meet the financial requirements, you must demonstrate that you have an amount of € 14.615,52 available in your personal bank account after transferring the applicable costs. **Please note that if you pay in installments, the applicable amount you should have available in your account is € 34.110,52**

The account must be in your name, allowing you unrestricted access to your funds. Standard checking accounts or regular savings accounts usually meet this requirement, but if you have a different type of account, you must demonstrate that you can freely withdraw funds from it. Certificates of deposit are only accepted if they explicitly state that you are allowed to withdraw the money without restrictions.

If you have a joint account with someone else, you must provide a written statement confirming that you have the authority to use the funds.

Proof of available funds can be demonstrated using one of the following documents:

- An original bank statement
- A copy of a bank account statement
- A printed screenshot from online banking

If using a foreign bank account, you must also submit the original bank statement. All documents must be less than three months old. Each document must include the following information:

- ✓ The date
- ✓ Your personal details, including at least your initials and surname
- ✓ The bank account number
- ✓ The account balance
- ✓ The bank's contact information, including website/email, branch address, and phone number.

### Option 3: Financial support from abroad

**Payment of the applicable costs € 22.906,11 and show proof of financial support of € 14.615,52**

To meet the financial requirements, your sponsor must demonstrate an amount of € 14.615,52 available in their personal bank account after transferring the applicable costs. **Please note that when you wish to pay in installments, the applicable amount your sponsor must have available is € 34.110,52 and the sponsor must declare that you will receive a monthly amount of € 2.842,55.**

This individual acts as your financial guarantor, holding at least 12 times the monthly study norm in their bank account to cover your studies in addition to the total amount of tuition fees.

Your guarantor must be able to withdraw funds freely from their account. A standard checking account or a regular savings account typically meets this requirement, but if your guarantor uses a different type of account, they must demonstrate that the funds can be withdrawn without restrictions.

If your guarantor has a joint account with someone else, a statement must be provided confirming that they are permitted to use the funds. You will need to submit the following documents:

- The Appendix '[Financial Statement of Support \(Private Person\)](#)';
- A copy of your financier's passport or identity document;
- Proof that the bank account is in your financier's name. This can be demonstrated with one of the following:
  - An original bank statement
  - A copy of a bank account statement
  - A printed screenshot from online banking All documents must be less than 3 months old and should contain the following information:
    - ✓ The date
    - ✓ The financier's personal details, including initials and surname
    - ✓ The bank account number
    - ✓ The balance
    - ✓ The bank's contact information, including website/email, branch address, and phone number

#### **Option 4: Financial support from someone in the Netherlands**

##### **Payment of the applicable costs € 22.906,11 and show proof of financial support of € 14.615,52**

To meet the financial requirements, your sponsor must demonstrate an amount of € 14.615,52 available in their personal bank account after transferring the applicable costs. **Please note that when you wish to pay in installments, the applicable amount your sponsor must have available is € 34.110,52 and the sponsor must declare that you will receive a monthly amount of € 2.842,55.**

This person serves as your financial guarantor and must demonstrate independent, sustainable, and sufficient income. To prove this, you will need to submit the following documents:

- The Appendix '[Financial Statement of Support \(Private Person\)](#)';
- An original extract from the Municipal Personal Records Database of the municipality where your financier resides. This extract should include the family composition and be less than 3 months old.
- Proof of the financier's income. The appendix 'Proof of Income' specifies which documents are required based on the financier's type of income. You can find this information via the link: [Income requirements study | IND](#)

#### **Option 5: Fully funded grant or scholarship**

##### **You have been awarded a fully funded grant or scholarship.**

To verify this, you need a scholarship declaration. This document must include the following details:

- The date
- The institution granting the scholarship\*
- Your personal details (initials, surname, and date of birth)
- The start and end dates of the scholarship
- The total scholarship amount
- Optionally, the name of the scholarship program

*\*If the educational institution grants you a scholarship on behalf of another organization, such as a company, the institution should keep a record of the agreement between themselves and the funding organization in their administration.*
