When do you use this form?

The Single Euro Payments Area (SEPA) covers the whole European Union, plus Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein as well as Switzerland, Monaco, San Marino, Andorra, Vatican City and United Kingdom.

If you do have a SEPA bank account, please issue the digital payment authorisation for tuition fees via Studielink. More information is available via www.thuas.com/tuitionfees.

Please ensure that the full amount due will be received by THUAS and keep in mind that any banking costs (if applicable) must be paid by you.

When do you submit this form?

After transferring the tuition fees or package fee, send this form – fully filled out and signed – along with a copy of the bank transfer, to The Hague University of Applied Sciences. You must always fill out the details of the account holder. Also, you must sign this form and indicate the signature date. Using this form will ensure that we can easily retrieve your payment.

Which tuition fee applies?

The statutory tuition fee amounts to € 2,530. The institutional tuition fee amounts to € 9,889. The halved statutory tuition fee amounts to € 1,265.
